

## **Moving Checklist**

ks Prior to Moving Day  Get estimates from moving companies, if you are using one  If you are moving yourself, obtain estimates from at least two truck rental companies  Start collecting boxes (if you are using a moving company they will often supply them)  Start making an inventory, with photographs, of everything you own  Start a file for all of you moving paperwork (estimates, receipts, etc)  Arrange to have school records and veterinarian records transferred
Visit your local Post Office to arrange your mail to be forwarded to your new home Notify your bank, insurance company, and friends and family of your move Make arrangements for storage if needed Ask your doctor for referrals, and obtain all medical records if required Begin purging your home and separate items into those you will keep, donate, discard, or sell in a yard sale Start using items that can't be moved such as frozen foods and cleaning supplies
Veeks Prior to Moving Day:  Schedule disconnection of all utility services at you old home and arrange for connection of services at your new home  If you are moving yourself, reserve a truck  If you are packing yourself, begin packing items you don't use often and make sure the boxes are clearly labeled with its contents and room  Check with insurance company to see how your possessions are covered during transit Collect important records and place them somewhere safe  Have your yard sale
Weeks Prior to Moving Day  Properly dispose of items that cannot be moved, such as flammable liquids  Prepare auto registration for transfer if applicable  Make child care arrangements for moving day if needed  Arrange for disposal of anything that did not sell at the moving sale
